


AIMS OF THE COMMITTEE

THE EPPO'S COLLEGE

On 30 November 2023, the eight new European Prosecutors that replaced the European Prosecutors who finished their three-year mandates* at the end of July 2023, gave solemn undertaking before the Court of Justice of the EU.

The new European Prosecutors are appointed for a six-year non-renewable mandate.

* According to Article 16(4) of the EPPO Regulation, "Every 3 years there shall be a partial replacement of one third of the European Prosecutors. The Council, acting by simple majority, shall adopt transitional rules for the appointment of European Prosecutors for and during the first mandate period".


INTER-INSTITUTIONAL COOPERATION

On 28-29 November 2023, the EPPO participated in the European Investment Bank (EIB) Fraud Fighters event organised by the EIB.

In this event, the EPPO, NATO, OLAF, EUROPOL, and ECA, together with several law enforcement agencies from across the world, discussed topics of common interest, focusing on cooperation with Ukraine and in the Balkans in investigating and prosecuting crimes against the EU's financial interests.

The EPPO presented the flagship operation 'Admiral', which proves the advantages of the EPPP's functioning as a single prosecution office across 22 participating Member States.





GENERAL UPDATE

These are the recent judgements we have compiled on fraud against EU funds from the past month, now available on our website.

Corte dei conti Piemonte, n 17/2023

In the judgment 17/2023, the Court of auditors sentenced two companies that received public funding from Invitalia to the implementation of the development programme for the conversion and requalification of the former Fiat Industrial Area, as well as their administrators, to pay a total amount of € 21.322.580,70 for having used the received contribution for completely different purposes.

Corte dei conti II C/A, n. 352/2023

In judgment no. 352/2023, the Court of Auditors II department of jurisdictional appeal, condemned two companies and their directors to pay a total of EUR 64,214,700 for fiscal damage. In particular, the unlawful conduct stems from the violation of the 'milk quota' regulations (abolished in 2015 with the re-establishment of the free market for dairy producers), burdening the companies as first purchaser for failure to pay the amounts collected.


Corte dei conti Liguria, n. 70/2023

The Court of Auditors, in the judgment under review, sentences the owner of the company to pay the sum of EUR 30,000.00 in favour of the Ministry of Enterprise and Made in Italy. In particular, the financial loss consisted in the diversion of the purposes for which the holder had requested the subsidised financing, pursuant to Article 13, Law Decree 23/2020).

AYUDAS DE LA PAC Y TRATAMIENTO DE LAS SUBVENCIONES

El Ministerio de Agricultura, Pesca y Alimentación abrió en junio un plazo para la solicitud de subvenciones a las organizaciones del sector agroalimentario que realicen actuaciones de apoyo en la presentación de la solicitud única a los beneficiarios de ayudas de la Política Agraria Común (PAC). La convocatoria tenía un presupuesto total de cuatro millones de euros. Se establece que la concesión de estas subvenciones se realizará en régimen de concurrencia competitiva.

"Para facilitar las gestiones de agricultores y ganaderos al tramitar sus ayudas conforme a los nuevos parámetros de la PAC 2023-2027, el Ministerio ha buscado el apoyo de las organizaciones profesionales agrarias y cooperativas agroalimentarias de carácter general y ámbito nacional.

Dichas entidades colaboradoras agroalimentarias ya han venido desarrollando actividades de apoyo en la tramitación y gestión de las solicitudes de ayuda de esta política comunitaria, desde hace décadas, pero es en este primer año de implantación de la nueva PAC cuando dicho apoyo resulta especialmente necesario. Con el objetivo de lograr dichos fines, el ministerio aprobó esta orden, cuyo objeto es regular la concesión de esta subvención excepcional mediante el sistema de concurrencia competitiva. La orden que establece las bases reguladoras destaca que las actuaciones a financiar serán las de apoyo a la presentación de los expedientes de solicitud única de ayudas de la PAC, así como la realización de tareas de promoción, formación y difusión relacionadas con las solicitudes de la PAC 2023".

Las subvenciones son una modalidad importante de gasto público y, por tanto, deben ajustarse a las directrices de la política presupuestaria. Uno de los principios que rige en España la Ley General de Subvenciones, inspirados en los de la Ley de Estabilidad Presupuestaria, es el de la transparencia. Con este objeto, las Administraciones deberán hacer públicas las subvenciones que concedan y, a la vez, la Ley establece la obligación de formar una base de datos de ámbito nacional que contendrá información relevante sobre todas las subvenciones concedidas.

Existe una gran diversidad de subvenciones y ayudas en el ámbito de la PAC de distinta naturaleza, que se conceden mediante procedimientos complejos, y, por lo tanto, deben ser objeto de un seguimiento y control eficaces.


Según el art 65 de la Ley general de subvenciones de 2003 "Las infracciones prescribirán en el plazo de cuatro años a contar desde el día en que la infracción se hubiera cometido ...".

Si bien la ley general de subvenciones en España prescribe que las infracciones prescribirán a los cuatro años a contar desde el día en que la infracción se hubiera cometido la interpretación que se hace para su aplicación es que el cómputo se hace desde que se termina la subvención, en cuanto que hasta ese momento se ha tenido tiempo o se ha podido realizar la corrección del defecto, o en cuanto que es a partir de ese momento desde el que se puede realizar una auditoría y control.

Pero estas interpretaciones jurisprudenciales o de parte de los órganos de control son incorrectas puesto que la administración está limitada por el principio de legalidad, por tanto, lo que le permite la ley es el límite posible de su actuación.


A diferencia del Derecho privado en el Derecho público la administración está acotada por lo especificado claramente por la ley. De este modo, en cualquier tipo de subvención sometida a este normativa el plazo de prescripción de los cuatro años debe contarse desde que se cometió la acción irregular o fraudulenta no desde que finalice la subvención, puesto que la literalidad de la norma es clara.

C-481/23, Sangas

Official publication was made of a request for a preliminary ruling from the Audiencia Nacional (Spain), lodged on 26 July 2023, in the context of criminal proceedings against JMTB.

The case concerns a European arrest warrant, issued by a Romanian court, requesting the transfer of a person convicted in the first instance for offenses relating to tax fraud and money laundering.

the referring court has decided to stay the proceedings and ask the Court of Justice to clarify the grounds for optional non-execution of a European arrest warrant, as enshrined in Articles 4(4) and 4(6) of the Council Framework Decision 2002/584/JHA on the European arrest warrant.

Specifically, the Spanish court has asked the Court of Justice to provide guidance on the following inquiries:

- (i) Since Article 4(6) of the Council Framework Decision 2002/584/JHA provides that the grounds for optional non-execution of the European arrest warrant include cases in which the European arrest warrant has been issued for the execution of a custodial sentence or detention order, where the requested person is staying in, or is a national or a resident of the executing Member State and that State undertakes to execute the sentence or detention order in accordance with its domestic law:
- a) Is it permissible to extend the application of that ground to cases in which a final decision has not yet been reached regarding the requested person?
- b) If that possibility were allowed, is it possible to refuse to surrender on the ground that the requested person is resident in the State in which enforcement is sought, without that State undertaking to execute the sentence or detention order in accordance with its domestic law?
- (ii) Since Article 4(4) of the Council Framework Decision of 13 2002/584/JHA provides that the grounds for optional non-execution of the European arrest warrant include cases where the criminal prosecution or punishment of the requested person is statute-barred according to the law of the executing Member State and the acts fall within the jurisdiction of that Member State under its own criminal law, is it permissible to extend that ground to cases in which the offense or penalty is regarded as statute-barred under the law of the executing Member State, even if the courts of that State do not have jurisdiction to determine the facts?




All the data collected is being analysed, and the investigation into the organised crime groups behind this scheme is continuing. The estimated damages investigated under Operation Admiral currently amount to €2.2 billion. Measures to recover the damages have been taken, and more details will be communicated once known.

First indictment in Investigation Admiral: 12
suspects and 15 companies charged with massive
VAT fraud

The European Public Prosecutor's Office (EPPO) in Porto (Portugal) filed an indictment today against 12 suspects and 15 companies, following an investigation into a massive intra-community VAT fraud scheme extending to over 30 countries, codenamed Admiral. This is the first indictment issued under investigation Admiral.

The defendants – ten Portuguese and two French nationals – are accused of setting up and operating a criminal organisation, based on the sale of electronic goods, which is understood to have committed several crimes of aggravated tax fraud, money laundering and active and passive corruption in the private sector, between 2016 and November 2022. Five of the accused are in pre-trial detention, including one under house arrest. Fourteen companies registered in Portugal and one registered in Cyprus are also accused.




